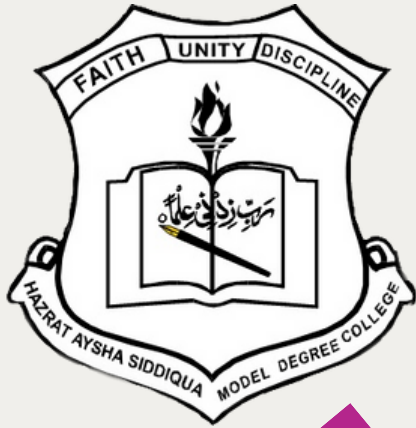

# 75TH CELEBRATION

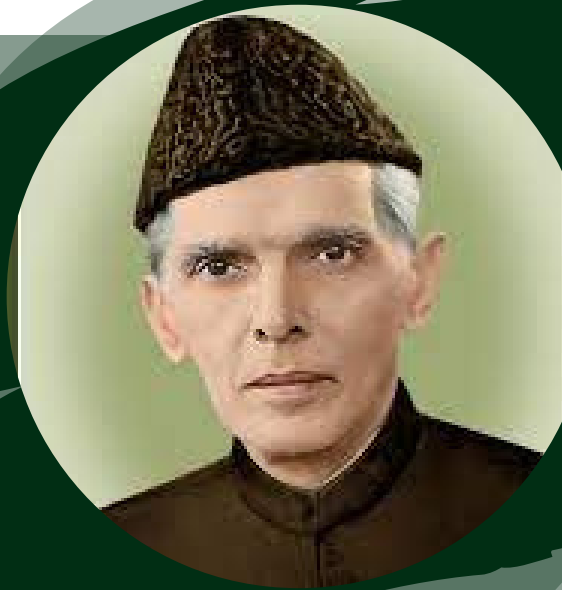


75th Independence Day was celebrated recently in college. Freedom is divine blessing for all and we are lucky to have a home land where we can live freely.

## INTERMEDIATE

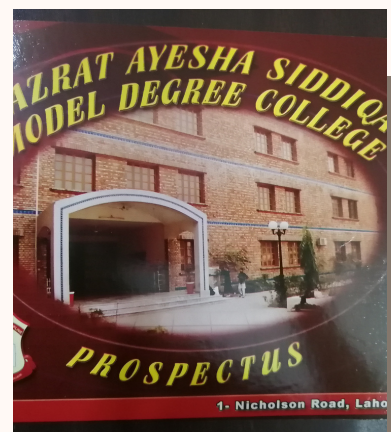
### UNITY
