Thus Islamic Architecture of different Era are of great interest to modern Era, not only for their unique type but also for rich designs n colours in endless variety into which they may be arranged .

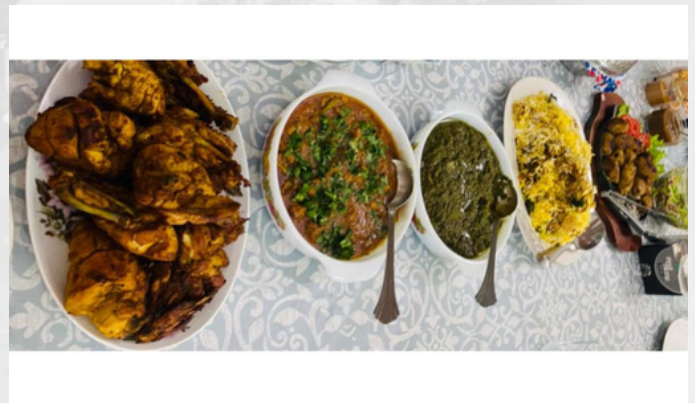






Cooking Competition

LECTURE ON ISLAMIC ETHICS

On 15th March, 2023 the college administration was honoured by inviting renowned Islamic scholar and speaker Dr. Memoona Murtaza.

Dr. Memoona Murtaza shared her valuable thoughts on Islamic Ethics with students. She emphasised that Islam does not mean only to offer prayers but actually it is a code of Islamic Ethics. Islamic Ethics includes kindness (to people and animals), charity, forgiveness, honesty, patience, justice, respecting parents and elders, keeping promises and controlling one's anger. She gave Quranic references. The Almighty ALLAH states in the Holy Quran:

"Most surely man is in loss except those who believe and do good and enjoin on each other truth, and enjoin on each other patience (103:2-3)."

Islam's moral system is striking in that it not only defines morality, but also guides the human race in how to achieve it, at both an individual as well as a collective level.



Dr. Memoona Murtaza added that if a person treats his fellow being with a good manner, he deserves two rewards, one for good ethic and another for her good representation of Islam. And the Prophet Mohammad (peace be upon him) says: ***"I was sent to perfect the noble qualities of character."***

At the end respected scholar invited students for questions, and answered them adequately. It was a really enlightening experience for both students and faculty.
